ENROLLMENT

This is a school regulation and must be received 2 weeks prior to the next billing cycle. **Tuition charges are based on enrollment not attendance.**

TUITION

Tuition is based on enrollment, not attendance.

Dance fees begin September 15th and end on May 15th. For your convenience tuition is divided into 9 monthly installments. Monthly payments: Online auto draft from your checking account or Debit Card. Credit card: Visa, MasterCard, or Discover. Discounts available for payment of Full Tuition or Semester Tuition. There are no refunds for missed or dropped classes. RETURN CHECK CHARGE IS \$25.00

DRESS CODE

Ballet & Lyrical: Leotard, tights or a skirt. Pink ballet shoes for girls/black for boys. Hair in a bun or braid away from face and neck. Boys: Solid color shirt and pants or shorts. Jazz & Tap: Leotard, tank shirt or jazz pants. Tan tie tap for 3 to 5 year Preschool class. Tan lace up oxford for dancers 6 and up in combo class. Tan lace less Jazz Shoes for Jazz. Hip Hop: Jazz or cargo pants with fitted tank shirt. Hip Hop boots, or Jazz sneakers - NO tennis shoes. Hair in ponytail or braid.

Our dress code is designed to encourage unity and discipline among our students. **DO NOT SEND YOUR CHILD IN A T-SHIRT AND SHORTS.**
