Tuition: \$75.00 per dancer

Dancers in preschool level classes need to be accompanied by one adult or guardian (at least 18 years old). Each dancer will receive their own bag of props to use in class. Dancers may keep their props following the summer session.

Female participants are required to wear a leotard, tights and appropriate ballet footwear. A ballet skirt or fitted dance bloomers/shorts may also be worn. Female dancers must style their hair in a bun. Male participants are required to wear a fitted white shirt, black athletic shorts and appropriate ballet footwear. Dancers are encouraged to bring a water bottle and sweat towel to the intensive.

Tuition: \$150.00 per dancer

Tuition Rates for Summer Dance Arts 2020

All tuition rates are based on enrollment, not on attendance. Tuition is non-refundable. Upon registration, a non-refundable \$10.00 deposit per dancer is due to hold your dancer's place in their class(es). The deposit will be credited towards your dancer's Summer Dance Arts tuition. Tuition for Summer Dance Arts classes is due on Tuesday, June 16th, 2020. Tuition for the Summer Dance Arts ballet intensive is due on Monday, June 29th, 2020. Tuition may be paid with credit card, debit card or check payable to Grayce DeWitt Dance Studio.

Health and Safety Protocols

To ensure we are prioritizing the health and safety of our faculty, our students and their families, we will be following protocol suggested by the CDC and the State of Arkansas Department of Health.

Class sizes will be limited in order to allow for adequate social distancing. The studio's lobby will be closed to family members and observers. All faculty, dancers and their parent/guardian (if accompanying their dancer for a PS class) will be screened prior to entering the dance school. There will be no entry for anyone who:

- has returned from travel to NY, NJ, CT, New Orleans or overseas within the last 14 days;
- has had a fever of 100.4°F or greater in the last 2 days;
- has had a cough, difficulty breathing, sore throat, or loss of taste or smell;
- has had contact with a person known to be infected with COVID-19 within the previous 14 days;
- has compromised immune systems and/or have chronic diseases

Temperature checks will occur for all faculty and dancers and any accompanying parent or guardian.

Face coverings are required for entry into the studio, but they may be removed during activity and dancing. If any dancer chooses to wear their mask while dancing, they'll need to look into the possible risks of mask wearing during physical activity, and accept full responsibility of any potential side effects. Hand sanitizer will be provided to everyone upon entry to the dance school and when leaving. It will also be available throughout the dance studio. Class times are staggered to allow for cleaning classrooms after each use. To avoid personal contact dancers will not engage in any exercises or choreography which requires partnering or contact with other students. Props will only be used in preschool level classes. Dancers in these classes will receive their own props for use during the session. Please disinfect props between each class meeting. Our water fountains will not be available for use. Our bathrooms will be limited to faculty and dancers only. We will continue to monitor and implement the local, state, and federal recommendations as they're announced and make changes as necessary. We will take each week, or day to day, into consideration as it approaches and keep you updated on what's happening. Thank you for your understanding and kind attention.
